

# 1010<sub>2</sub> Years of CLEI Electronic Journal

## Abstract

This document presents an historical overview of the CLEI Electronic Journal editions in its 10th anniversary, with particular details in the period that has started in 2005. The article describes the activities that has been made to improve the journal presentation and finally proposing some actions that tend to index it in Scielo (Scientific Electronic Library Online).

**Keywords:** Electronic journal, CLEI, Journal History.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

In 1997 the Latinamerican Center for Informatics Studies (CLEI for its initials in Spanish) [1] has created an electronic journal so a greater visibility can be given to the research work and scientific and technological advances of the region. In June 1998 the first Volume and Number of the CLEI Electronic Journal (CLEI EJ) [2] was published. That number was dedicated to the best 5 papers presented in the CLEI Conference of 1996 in Bogota, Colombia. The Editor of the journal from 1998 till 2004 was Prof. Ricardo Baeza-Yates, who pursued many actions to make known the journal and kept it alive. Since 2005, the Editor of the journal is Prof. Mauricio Solar.

CLEI EJ is registered in Chile and has the international identification code ISSN 0717-5000 (International Standard Serial Number). CLEI EJ is already indexed in Digital Bibliography & Library Project (DBLP) [3] under the classification of Computer Science Journals. This provides an excellent visibility to the journal. CLEI EJ is also indexed by Latindex (Sistema Regional de Información en Línea para Revistas Científicas de América Latina, el Caribe, España and Portugal) [4], under the number 10872. It has been recently incorporated to DOAJ (Directory of Open Access Journals) [5].

After 10 years of history, the CLEI EJ still remain basically active through the edition of special issues, in which the best papers of the CLEI conferences and other international conferences are published, but mainly regional conferences.

In the last years, the journal has grown basically based on the submission of papers by authors from countries of other continents like Europe and Asia as regular papers.

This report presents an historical overview of the different numbers and volumes of the journal with particular detail in the last 4 years, describing the activities taken to improve the general management of the journal and proposing new actions for the journal to be included in the Scielo index [6].

## 2. HISTORICAL SUMMARY OF CLEI EJ

The Editor-in-Chief of CLEI EJ has the support of an Editorial Committee with 14 members that help in the revision of the submitted papers. The Editorial Committee members are the following:

Table 1 shows all the volumes and numbers of CLEI EJ in the 10 years of its life listed from June 1998 till June 1998. In 1999, the edition of the first number of Volume 2 was delayed by a difficult evaluation process. This number appeared later on 2001 as the first number of Volume 4. The unique year in which only one number was published was 2003.

As can be seen in Table 1, most of the numbers are related to “special issues” as result of the best papers submitted to the CLEI Conference since 1996 in Bogotá till 2006 in Santiago, Chile. The selection of papers of the CLEI Conference in 2007 in San Jose, Costa Rica, has been edited in December 2008 as Volume 11 Number 2 under the responsibility of the guest editors Drs. Marcelo Jenkins and Manuel Bermudes. In 2005, Volume 8 and Number 2 was dedicated to a selection of the best papers presented at CIESC 2004 (Arequipa, Peru) and later CIESC 2005, published in 2007 under Volume 10, Number 1, with the guest editors Drs. Camilo Rueda and Angel Garcia Baños.

Other special numbers has been dedicated to Collaboration Researchers’ International Workshop on Groupware (CRIWG’ 98), Iberoamerican Conference on Software Engineering and Knowledge Engineering (ICSEKE 2001), Jornada Iberoamericana de Ingeniería de Software e Ingeniería del Conocimiento (JIISIC 2003) and Workshop de Ingeniería de Software (WIS 2005). All the details are shown in Table 1.

Details of the papers published in each number are included in Annex 1. In the first 7 years CLEI EJ has published 49 papers and in the last 3 years, there has been 40 published papers, without counting the 3 articles of June 2008 number nor the 8 ones of the December 2008 number. In total, there has been 100 articles published in 10 years, but it is quite important to notice the growth of the last years. This can be explained mainly because Latinamerican authors are more interested in publishing in CLEI EJ as the journal is indexed in DBLP, Latindex and DOAJ.

In Annex 1 the name of all the authors of CLEI EJ is listed. It can be noticed that there are 226 authors coming from 15 different countries. Ten authors have two papers, four have 3, one has four and another one has 5 articles. The number of authors is interesting, but it is important to notice that 210 of the 226 authors have not published again in the journal.

The number of articles that have been published as “special issues” and the number of articles published as “regular issues” are shown in Table 2. As can be seen, the later has grown in the last years.

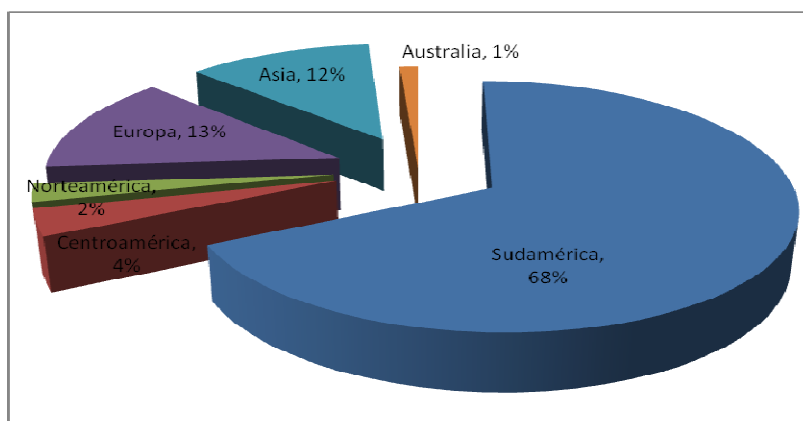
### 3. NUMBERS IN THE PERIOD 2005-2008

One of the interesting aspects that are shown in Table 3 is the origin of the papers published in the journal in the last years. In the first place, new articles of authors coming from Japan, India and Australia has been incorporated, and this fact introduces new areas where the journal will have impact in the near future. This takes the journal to global scope. In general, most of the articles come from Latinamerica, one from Centeramerica, and 1.5 from Northamerica, plus several papers coming from France and Spain. In Figure 1, the distribution of the papers considering the origin is shown for the period 2005-2008. Figure 2 shows the distribution of published articles from Latinamerica in the same period, and these represent almost 70% of the total published papers in the period.

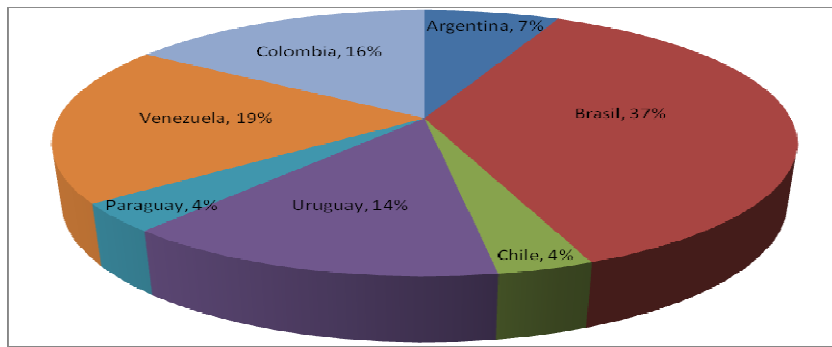
It is important to notice the presence of India with 9%, with the same quantity of articles from Uruguay.

Table 4 presents the growth of the relation between regular papers and special issues in the last years. It is important to notice that a large quantity of papers have been received for evaluation, but that have been rejected for different reasons. It can be mentioned that in general many of these rejected papers are computational applications developed by experts in different areas, and that have no significant contribution for the computer science area.

#### 4. ACTIONS TAKEN

Many actions have been done to improve the journal. Among them the document “Instructions for Authors” is published in the web page of the journal.

On the other hand, it has been improved the “Evaluation Form” in order to facilitate the evaluation of regular papers.

To handle the processing of papers, the system MyReview has been adapted because it is stable and secure. With it the evaluation of regular papers is more simple.

#### 5. CONCLUSIONS AND FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The diffusion of an electronic journal like CLEI EJ is a very important aspect. The inclusion of the journal in international indexes like DBLP, Latindex and DOAJ has contributed to improve its impact factor. In this sense, the inclusion in Scielo seems to be really very important.

One of the requirements of Scielo for indexing a journal in the computer science area in Chile is to have three numbers per year. Up to 2008, the CLEI EJ has regularly published two numbers a year, one in June and the other in December. To satisfy this requirement a new number is included starting in 2009. CLEI EJ will publish three numbers in April, August and December.
